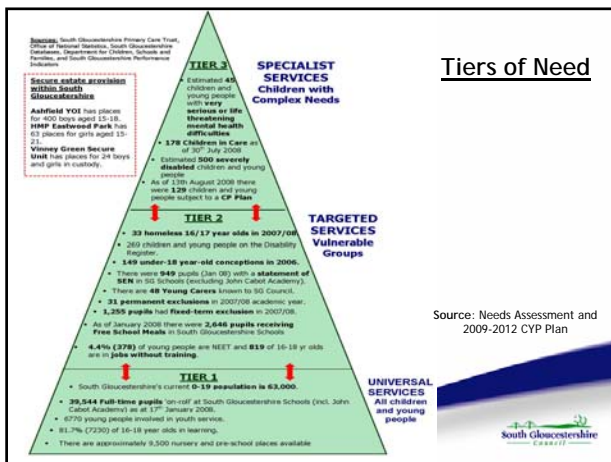

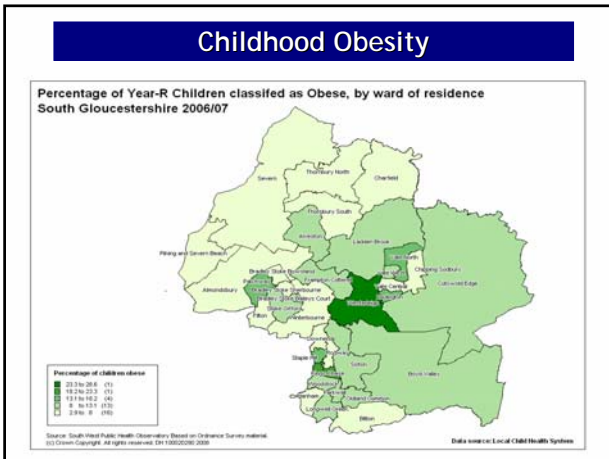

### Drugs and Alcohol Misuse

Drug and alcohol fixed term exclusions have increased - from 31 in 2006/07 to 78 in 2007/08.

The majority of Child Protection Plans are for the Categories of Emotional Abuse (42.7%) and Neglect (32%), thus reflecting the impact of parental drug/alcohol misuse and domestic violence.

### Children in Care

As at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2009 9.2% of children classified as 'In Care' were BME - a higher proportion than is found in the wider population (6%).

The number of children in care aged 10 or over that have been cautioned or convicted has risen from 8 (2.9%) to 12 (4.8%) between 2005/06 and 2006/07.
